### 30. Portsea Quarantine Station to Fort:

Point Nepean Quarantine Station offers a glimpse into the early European history of Victoria. Established in 1852, explore nearly 50 heritage-listed buildings. Shuttle Bus to Fort Nepean is available. Fort Nepean is one of the fortifications that protected Melbourne during World War I and II. Located at the very tip of the Mornington Peninsula, where the calm waters of Port Phillip meet the wild waves of the Southern Ocean, explore the extensive tunnel complex which connects the historic gun emplacements.

### 31. Shrine of Remembrance Tour Melbourne:

The Shrine of Remembrance is a war memorial in Melbourne. It was built to honor the men and women of Victoria who served in World War I, but now functions as a memorial to all Australians who have served in any war.
